Pupils in year 6 have been invited to participate in The Great Causton Bake Off. The competition consists of two rounds: the first round is on Monday 25th January and the final is on Thursday 28th January.

Monday 25th January

The first round will be held in school. Your child is invited to bake something sweet or savoury at school. Your child shouldn't forget to bring the ingredients and recipe to school. **The bake can't contain any nuts.** The cakes will be judged and 6 pupils will be selected to go to the final. To be selected for the first round the candidates need to fill the slip at the bottom of this page. A maximum of 12 candidates will be selected for the first round.

Thursday 28th January

Each finalist will be asked to undertake two baking challenges in school. The final will consist of: a technical challenge (recipe and ingredients will be provided on the day) and a show stopper challenge. This should be based on the theme of school life and can be planned in advance. Your child shouldn't forget to bring the ingredients and recipe for the showstopper to school as this will need to be baked by them in school. The bakes will be judged on three criteria: taste, appearance and originality of design. All bakes will be sold to raise money for the school. The winner will be announced during afternoon assembly on Thursday 28th January.
