Residential Visit 31st October – 4th November 2016

We have enough places to offer all pupils who send in their deposits and applications. Pupils not participating in the visit will take part in an activities week in school. The cost of the activity week and details are issued to parents in the autumn term.

This will be our fourth visit to Thorpe Woodlands which is run by Suffolk Outdoor Education. The children will be staying at the fully accessible centre which is perfectly situated for a wide range of land and water-based outdoor activities, and offers a superb environment in which young people and adults can learn, develop and have an amazing amount of FUN! Over the years we have received extremely positive feedback and praise from participating pupils (and their parents) for an action-packed, exciting and informative residential week. We feel that the visit will be of excellent value, with the children having the opportunity of experiencing a variety of outdoor activities which will include some of the following; abseiling, archery, caving, climbing, low ropes, shelter building etc.

The cost of the visit will be £208. All parents are invited to make a voluntary contribution to cover the cost of the visit. It must be stated, however, that the school does not have funds available to assist all parents with the full cost. Those pupils in receipt of the Pupil Premium may use their allowance in the 2015-2016 & 2016-2017 to help cover the cost. If you are not in receipt of the Pupil Premium and cost will prohibit your child from attending the Residential please contact Mrs Julia Shaw, Head of School. The school will be funding the travel cost.

If you are prepared to make full voluntary contributions towards the cost of the visit then we would be grateful if you would return the signed agreement slip below together with a **non-returnable £35 deposit by Friday 4th March 2016.**

Further payments of £35.00 will be expected on the last school day of each month from April to and including July, with a final payment of £33.00 being made on 30th September 2015.
